

2021 CIMP Inspection Status

Capital Improvement and Maintenance Program (CIMP) inspections were developed during Phase I of the AASP as a systematic way to identify airport needs, both capital and maintenance related, and document current conditions across the Alaska airport system. The State of Alaska DOT&PF is responsible for the maintenance and operation of 237 airports spanning an area one-fifth the size of the lower 48 states. With limited personnel, extreme weather events, and declining budgets, CIMP inspection data is a crucial tool in the planning, project development, and maintenance of Alaska's airports.

The AASP team continues to work with users of the inspection application to improve and streamline the process.
