

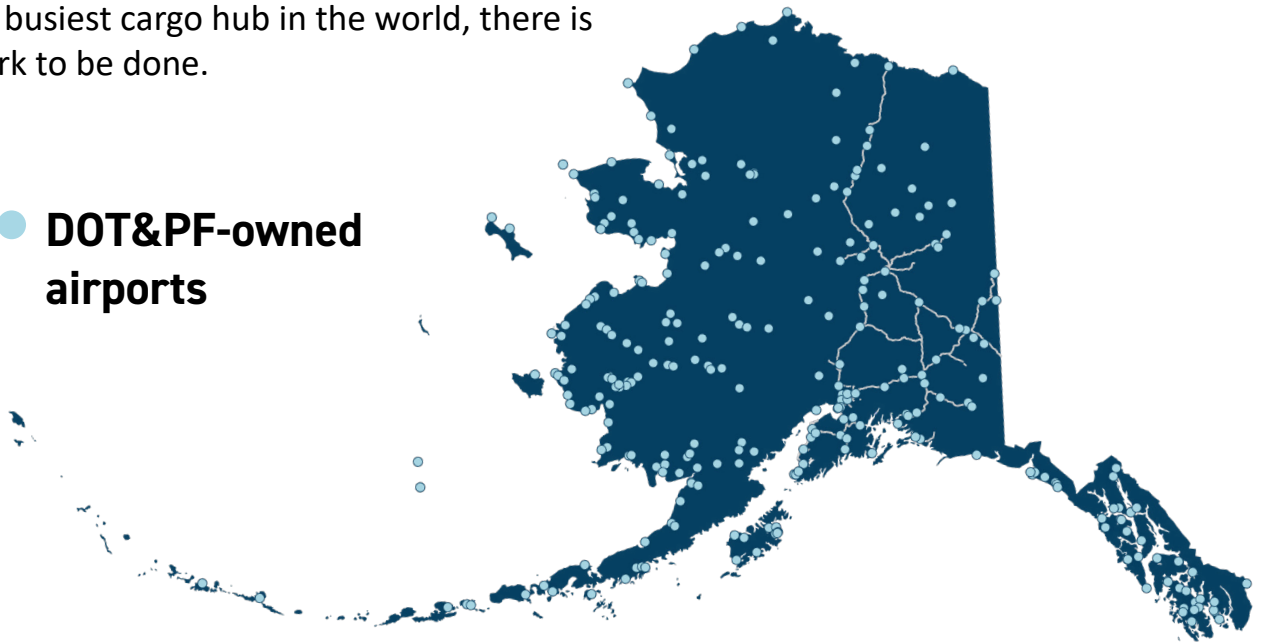


Introduction to Alaska Aviation

Expansive System

Alaska is the biggest state in the country and has an aviation system to match, including:

- » nearly **2.5 million square miles** of airspace
- » **394 public-use** airports
- » **237 DOT&PF-owned** airports
- » **60 times less road coverage** but **6 times more pilots per capita**, compared to the national average
